#### PRINCIPAL REPORT



#### WELCOME BACK!

What a fantastic couple of weeks! It was so nice to see all of our children return last Monday and quickly settle back in to school. It was obvious from the enthusiasm and the smiling faces that the children had really missed school, especially their friends. It's just not quite the same via webex! We also saw some excited parents who danced and tooted their car horns as they dropped their children off on the first day. A positive to remote learning is that students, parents and staff appreciate being at school that extra bit more!

During term 4 we will continue to settle the children back in to the daily routine of school life and focus on their social and emotional well being. We will help them to reunite with friends and develop the social skills and relationships they have missed over the past few months.

A further focus for this year will be to support children in English and Mathematics, especially in relation to essential skills that students may have missed during remote learning. We will be assessing the students and setting goals and strategies from their point of need. We are committed to doing the best we can to make up for the lost time.

Given the disruption to the school year, the Education Department has asked schools to focus on the following areas for the remainder of this year and in to the new year. As schools start their planning for 2021 they have been asked to set goals in the following three areas:

#### Learning catch-up and extension:

Some of our students have thrived in the remote and flexible learning environment, others have maintained their learning progress, and some have fallen behind, despite their best efforts and those of their families and teachers. We will support both those who need to catch up and those who have thrived to continue to extend their learning. The Department of Education will hopefully be providing funding to go towards tutors to support the catch up process.

#### Happy, active and healthy kids:

We will make sure that we look after our students' mental health and enable every student to get back outdoors, get active and get creative. This means providing programs and resources that focus on the social and emotional capability of the Victorian Curriculum and effectively mobilising available resources to support our students, especially the most vulnerable.

#### Connected schools:

We will build on the stronger connections that our school has established with families, carers and communities through 2020 to embed and spread improved ways of working to support our students.

We are excited to be back and committed to providing the best support and learning opportunities for our students.

#### **PARENT OPINION SURVEY**

This week all families received an email with an invitation to participate in the parent opinion survey. The Parent Opinion Survey is an annual survey offered by the Department of Education to assist schools in gaining an understanding of parents' perceptions of school climate, student behaviour, student engagement and experiences of remote and flexible learning.

Our school will use these survey results to help inform and direct future school planning and improvement strategies. The survey will be conducted **online**, only takes **20 minutes** to complete, and can be accessed at any convenient time from **Monday 12**<sup>th</sup> **October** to **Friday 13**<sup>th</sup> **November.** It can be completed on desktop computers, laptops, tablets or smartphones.

We would really appreciate your feedback and encourage you to complete the survey. Results and feedback will then be provided to the community through the newsletter once they have been issued.

# ATTITUDES TO SCHOOL SURVEY YEARS 4-6

We value student voice as a means to improving student engagement, wellbeing and quality instruction and are conducting a survey to find out what our students think of our school. The AtoSS is an annual student survey offered by the Department of Education and Training to assist schools in gaining an understanding of students' perceptions and experience of school. This year, the survey also includes some questions about student health and wellbeing and student perceptions of COVID-19.

Understanding health and wellbeing needs has always been important, but especially so this year, and the Department is providing this survey to allow schools to capture this information to support students. Students will be asked about their thoughts and feelings in relation to their school, family, friends, health (including mental health) and wellbeing, and bullying.

This year, the AtoSS will be conducted at our school over the period Monday 26th October until Friday 13th November. Whilst we would like all children to complete this survey, it is optional this year. An email will come home prior to this period of time asking parents to indicate if they **do not** want their children to participate.

#### **CSEF (CAMPS, SPORTS, EXCURSION FUND)**

CSEF payments will be at 50 percent of the standard primary rates, recognising that opportunities for camps, sports and excursions have been limited in 2020.



Re-opening of retail store for click-and-collect purchases

We are writing to inform you that from Monday 28th of September, your local Beleza store will be re-opening for click-and-collect purchases. While we would love to be able to re-open for in-store service, we are still unable to do so under the current Victorian government restrictions for Metro areas. In order to ensure that families can still purchase uniforms that they require, we're introducing a free-of-charge click-and-collect system, the details of which are outlined below.

Our online click-and-collect service will be up and running on Wednesday 23rd of September. To arrange a click-and-collect purchase from your local Beleza store, head to our website at <a href="https://store-beleza.com.au.">https://store-beleza.com.au.</a> From here, you can organise the items that you require, and when reaching the checkout, you can select click-and-collect purchase, and choose which store you will be collecting from. Please note that we will only allow purchases to be collected from stores that the school's uniform is stocked in. Once we've received your order, we will arrange stock as necessary, and our retail staff will contact you to arrange a time for collection, within the operating hours provided below.

We understand that our reduced operating hours may not work with the schedules of all families. To accommodate this, we will be continuing our 50% off shipping costs for purchases delivered throughout Victoria.

Please note that in order to ensure that our business is compliant with the government's COVID-19 regulations, we will not be open to the general public for walk-in transactions, and unfortunately cannot allow try-ons. All visits to our store will need to be organised in advance. As such, if you are hoping to arrange an exchange or refund on items that you've purchased online, please contact us at <a href="mailto:beleza@beleza.com.au">beleza@beleza.com.au</a>, and we will arrange for you to do so in a way that complies with the restrictions that we currently have to operate under. Please note that any exchange or refund requests will be subject to our existing terms and conditions.

This service will only be available until retail stores are allowed to re-open to full trade. Once we're given the all-clear from the Victorian government, we'll be returning to the same model of in-store service that we've provided in the past, and will no longer offer click-and-collect services.

Changes to our VIP sale approach for 2020

We are writing to advise you of the changes that we will be making for this year's VIP sale season. We're excited to offer a VIP season again this year, but have had to change our approach following the impacts of COVID-19, in order to ensure that we can hold the sale in a way that still protects the health and safety of our customers and team.

In previous years, we've offered a 20% discount over a one-week period. As we're sure you can imagine – and some of you would have experienced – this can bring a lot of traffic into the stores at one time, which we as a company felt would be too big of a risk in the current circumstance. 
