Pedal racers were a blast! We had races and tried to beat our top speeds!



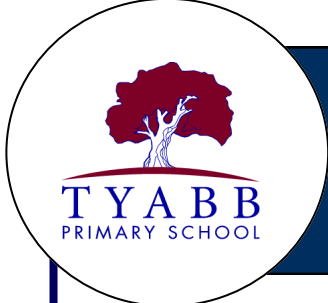
We walked to the beach. Then the challenge was to build a sand vehicle that would fit all four team members inside.



The view was amazing from the top of the flying fox, giant swing and pinnacle!



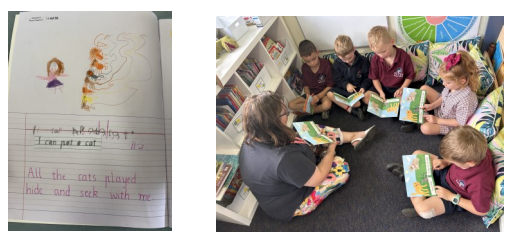




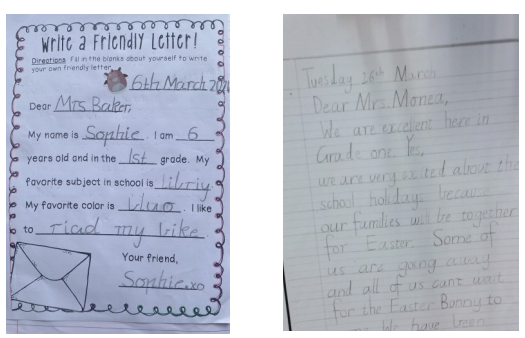
## English at Tyabb PS

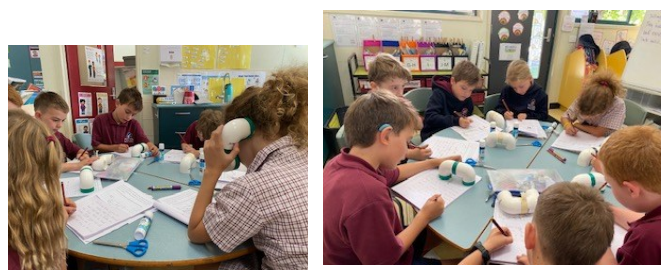
**In Foundation, students are starting reading groups with their teacher and have been writing sentences with CVC words.**



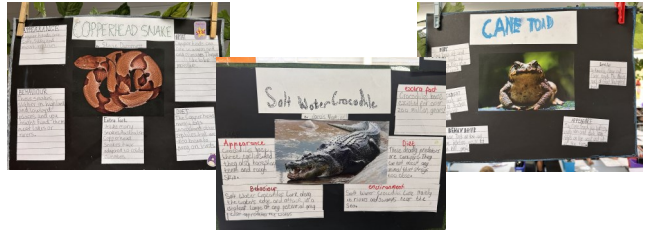
**Letter writing has been the focus in Grade 1. They have been learning the features and important parts to include in a letter.**



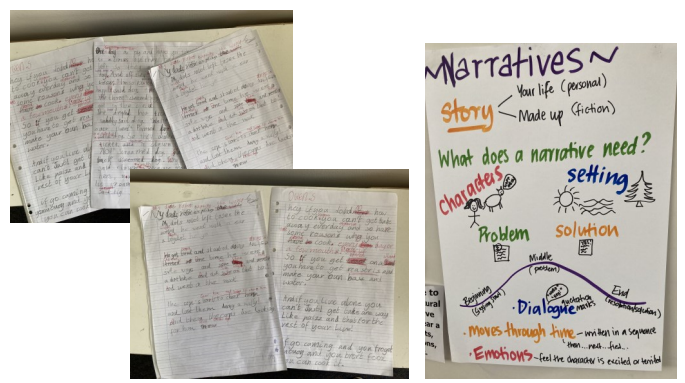
**In Grade 2, students have been using Whisper Phones to revise their writing. They listen to how it sounds and make changes.**



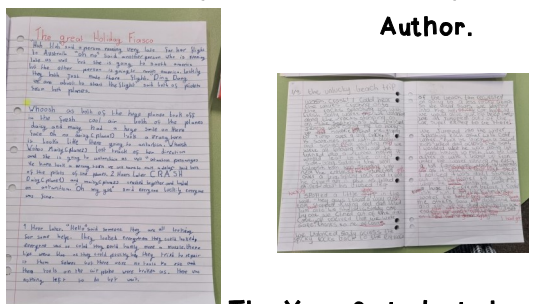
**The Grade 3 Students know all about the Writing Process; they went through each stage to create Non-Fiction Animal texts.**



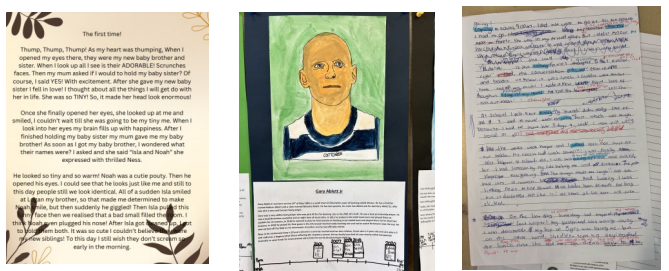
**The Grade 4s have been writing Narratives and learning how to revise effectively. They have zoomed in on their use of dialogue and organisation.**
