#### **ENROLMENTS FOR 2025**

Enrolments for 2025 are fairly stable and we will begin next year with approximately 425 students. If you will not be returning to Tyabb next year, please let us know as this may have an impact on the grade structures we have planned. We have planned an 18 grade structure for 2025 as shown below:

During November we will start to work out classes for 2025. The placement of children in grades is a complex task, taking into account the academic and social characteristics of each child, friendship groups and special circumstances. These decisions are well thought out and will not be changed once allocated.

At this stage we have not placed teachers in certain year levels as we always consider staff preferences and new staff that might be joining us. Please know that we do not take requests for particular teachers or students unless there are exceptional circumstances or the student has specific learning or behavioural needs.

# **Curriculum Corner**



#### **TERM 4 in the SCIENCE LAB**

Students have been studying physical sciences this term during their science lessons.



Foundation students have been looking at the way their bodies and objects move and how different conditions can affect that movement.







Grade 1 and 2

students have

been studying the way sounds are created and the way they travel through different materials. They listened to sounds travelling through a solid when they made telephones with paper cups and string. They also heard differences in sound made by spoons, hanging on string that were clanged against the edge of a table. When the string was put near their ears, it was like listening to bells ringing! Sounds were also made from the vibrations of swinging coat hangers, twanging elastic bands and talking on a balloon while rice 'danced' from the

vibrations of a beating drum.


















Grade 3 and 4 students have been investigating 'Heat', looking at different heat sources and how heat moves from one object to another. Through hands—on activities and discussions, the students talked about how we keep our bodies warm and cool them down, and also looked at the way animals adapt their bodies to do likewise. We distinguished between primary and secondary sources of heat and looked for some of these sources at home and at school.





This term, we have also been watching silkworms grow and develop. They started as eggs that hatched in to very thin, tiny, thread like creatures that have now, the form of a silkworm. They will start to make cocoons soon, then turn into moths.





Last term students were studying Chemistry. They had fun dissolving skittles, making lava lamps and investigating density by layering different liquids and seeing how they could separate from each other.


