

### NAPLAN DISRUPTION

As you will be aware via the media, Grade 5 NAPLAN testing was significantly impacted yesterday morning by technical issues with the national assessment platform across Australia. Our grade 5 students were unable to do the writing assessment but were able to catch up on this assessment today.

ACARA (Australian Curriculum, Assessment & Reporting Authority) recognises the significant impact to students disrupted during their NAPLAN writing assessments and apologises unreservedly. They have confirmed that testing has now resumed after the initial incident. They have reassured us that measures are in place to ensure students are not disadvantaged as a result of this technical issue. Schools have been informed to continue NAPLAN testing as per their planned test schedules.

For Parent/Carers of students in Grade 3 & 5 completing Naplan Testing,

**The National Assessment Program (NAPLAN)** – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) for Years 3, 5, 7 and 9 students are held in March each year. In 2026, the NAPLAN Online test window is between **Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> March and Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> March, 2026.**

Please note that Monday 9<sup>th</sup> March is Labour Day Public Holiday, and that all Naplan testing for grades 3 and grade 5 will begin on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> March at 9:15am.

NAPLAN tests assess student knowledge and skills in writing, reading, conventions of language (spelling, grammar and punctuation) and numeracy. The results of the tests provide information for students, parents, teachers and principals and can be used to improve student achievement.

NAPLAN tests are delivered in an online format. This delivers many benefits including:

- a ‘tailored test’ design that adapts to correct and incorrect student responses providing a more precise understanding of student achievement.
- innovative use of technology, including a more engaging test design and a wider range of item types;
- an extended and more flexible test window, allowing schools greater opportunity to schedule the tests at times that suit them best and increase student participation.

A [public demonstration site](https://www.nap.edu.au/naplan/public-demonstration-site) is available for schools, teachers, parents, carers and students to familiarise themselves with the online tests. (<https://www.nap.edu.au/naplan/public-demonstration-site>). Where it asks for student code/name please just click ‘next’, ‘yes’ and ‘test;’ to get to the example questions (these appear after the practice log in screens).

Later in the year you will receive your child’s personal NAPLAN report. The report will describe your child’s particular skills in reading, writing, conventions of language (spelling, grammar and punctuation) and numeracy. The report will also show how your child performed in relation to national minimum standards. These standards are for students across Australia.

We are confident that the information you receive as a result of your child’s participation in the NAPLAN tests will be valuable in helping you to assess your child’s progress.

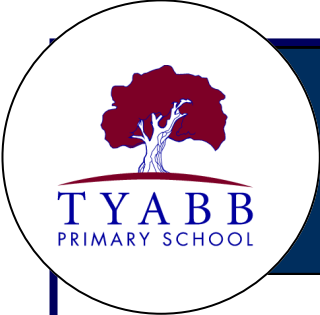

On Tuesday the 10th of March, the Grade 3-6 students competed in the annual House Cross Country held on the oval and in Olivers Creek.

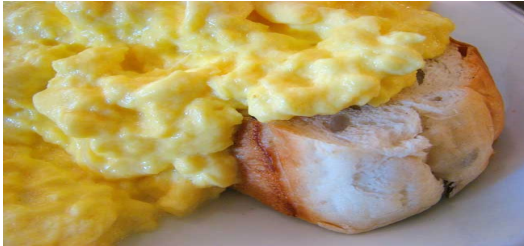
Students competed in the age they are turning or have turned this year with the 10 and under students completing a 2km track and the 11s and 12/13 year olds completing a 3km track.

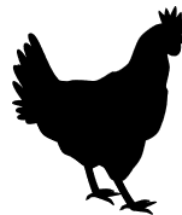
I would like to say a big thank you to all the parents and staff for their efforts in helping with the House Cross Country. Your help is always appreciated and is needed for these events to go ahead.

For every dollar you save, you'll get a dollar from ANZ to spend on educational costs, up to \$500.

To join, you need to meet all of these requirements:

- ✓ Be 18 years or older
- ✓ Have a current Health Care or Pensioner Concession Card
- ✓ Be in receipt of an eligible Commonwealth social security benefit, allowance or payment
- ✓ Have a child in school, starting school next year, or be studying yourself
- ✓ Get a regular income (can be you or your partner)
- ✓ Agree to join in free online financial education workshops
